- 1. Sheep must bear a current shearing tag in accordance with NSW Stud Merino Breeders' Association Rule No. 19.
- 2. All March shorn entries must have a side sample taken between 11th and 29th December 2023. Side samples are to be forwarded to AWTA, 24 Robertson Street, Kensington Vic 3031 along with the enclosed form.
- 3. A Grand Champion Merino Ram and Ewe will be selected from the class champions. There will be no Reserve Grand Champion Merino Ram or Ewe.
- 4. A Junior Champion Ram and Ewe will be selected from the winners of all 2 tooth and under classes. Polls are not eligible.
- 5. A Champion Junior Exhibit will be selected from the Junior Champion Ram and Ewe.
- 6. There will be a Champion Junior Poll Merino Ram and a Champion Junior Poll Merino Ewe. There will be no overall Junior Poll Exhibit.
- 7. Most Successful Exhibitor will be decided on the following points score: First 3 points, Second 2 points, Third 1 point; Champion 2 points, Grand Champion 1 point. Groups included in Award.
- 8. A National Vendor Declaration and National Sheep Health Statement are to be returned with the entry form.

- 9. No late arrivals after 10am Monday 26th February 2024 will be accepted. Judging will commence at 1pm sharp on Monday 26th February 2024.
- 10. Exhibitors may display additional information on, or next to, the official cards for the show and sale sheep upon request.
